

About artGroupie













Hone Heke was the charismatic Ngapuhi warrior who was gravely insulted when after signing the Treaty of Waitangi' with the British, and being told that the United Tribes Of New Zealand flag would be flown, the British shifted it to a different flag, the British flag. This started a whole bunch of wars with Heke, who chopped down the flag 4 times, only for it to be reinstated with the British flag. The fourth attack marked the beginning of the Northern Wars which culminated the destruction of Kororareka, now known as Russell, in the Bay of Islands. Whilst the Treaty of Waitangi appeared to be a fair union between the Maori People and the British, it favoured heavily for the Crown, and thus caused much disillusion with the treaty and what it actually meant to the Maori people. The cutting down of the flag was intended to express the displeasure of Hone Heke and to show his formidable warrior skills as they defeated the British troops many a time. However, I like to think that his wife, Hariata, had a hand in it as she appeared by his side many a time. This is the painting I have created to honour Hone Heke and his wife, or assistant, Hariata, and highlight the cheeky disposition they were both known to have.
